**SITUATION REPORT**

**INCIDENT NAME:** DeHarts Marina/Fuel Dock, Juneau

**SITREP #:** 1

**SPILL NUMBER:** 04119926501

**TIME/DATE OF SPILL:** September 21, 2004, Time: unknown. Juneau Police Department reported the spill to DEC at 4:21 AM

**TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT:** September 21, 2004, 2:00 PM.

**TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT:** September 21, 2004, 2:00 PM.

**TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED:** Diesel, and gasoline. Estimated 35 gallons of gasoline and 1,600 gallons of diesel fuel were spilled according to Petro Marine Services .

**LOCATION:** DeHarts Marina/Fuel Dock, Auke Bay, Juneau, Alaska.

**CAUSE OF SPILL:** Ruptured fuel lines and a failed shut-off valve at the diesel tank serving the DeHarts Marina dock. Cause is under investigation at this time.

**POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP):** Petro Marine Services, Juneau, Alaska

**RESPONSE ACTION:** Juneau Fire Department responded to a report of strong fuel odors at the DeHarts Marina and found the dock on fire. The Juneau Police/Fire dispatcher notified the USCG and ADEC of the spill. The Coast Guard and ADEC responded to the incident. Petro Marine Services, the owners of the fuel facility at DeHarts Marina, were notified and responded with their personnel and their response contractors SE Alaska Lighterage (SEAL) and SEAPRO. The Juneau Fire Department was able to extinguish the fires and are presently investigating the cause of the incident. Petro Marine Services and their response contractors, SEAL and SEAPRO, along with the USCG personnel, and ADEC personnel continue conducting a response to the incident and are presently deploying spill response booms and absorbent materials to contain and collect the spilled oil. Response equipment from the ADEC Auke Bay response container, the ADEC Juneau warehouse, and from the SEAL's warehouse have been deployed. Additional response equipment from Petro Marine Services and SEAPRO are being collected and transported to Auke Bay as needed. No boats were reported to be damaged by the fire. There was fire damage to the shore side section of the DeHarts dock and its ramp. No injuries have been reported.

**SOURCE CONTROL:** Fuel lines from the marina's three fuel tanks were reportedly checked and the shut-off valves remain closed and locked. No further discharges have been found.

**RESOURCES AFFECTED:** Fuel has been observed throughout Auke Bay Boat Harbor and extending beyond the jetty. Personnel are conducting inspections north of Auke Bay to determine the extent of pollution beyond Auke Bay. Although sea birds are typically found in and around Auke Bay, no oiled wildlife have been found.

**FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS:** Booming and recovery of the oil will continue until all oil is either recovered or recovery is found to be impossible.

**WEATHER:** Rain. Winds calm. Temp. low 50's.
