SITUATION REPORT

INCIDENT NAME: Horseshoe Lake Mystery Sheen

SITREP #: 3 and final

SPILL NUMBER: 05249902001

LEDGER CODE: 14144860

TIME/DATE OF SPILL: On January 20, 2005 at 4:25 PM ADEC received an anonymous complaint of an oil sheen flowing from a storm drain outflow into Horseshoe Lake in Kodiak, Alaska.

TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: 1:00 PM October 3, 2006

TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT: This is the final report.

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: Heating oil. The actual amount released is unknown. A small flow of oil sheen was discharging from the storm drain outflow into Horseshoe Lake during times of heavy rainfall. The discharge has been stopped.

LOCATION: The release occurred approximately four hundred and fifty (450) meters up gradient of Horseshoe Lake at the Alderwood Townhouses in Kodiak, Alaska.

CAUSE OF SPILL: A leaking underground heating oil tank at the Alderwood Townhouse building.

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): Alderwood Townhouse Association

RESPONSE ACTION: Alderwood Townhouse Association emptied their underground fuel tank and replaced it with an above ground tank. They are continuing to excavate the contaminated soil.

SOURCE CONTROL: The leaking tank has been emptied and removed.

RESOURCES AFFECTED: The City of Kodiak's storm water drainage system and Horseshoe Lake.

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: The Department is working with Alderwood Townhouse Association to cleanup any remaining contaminated soil and to evaluate and upgrade their heating oil systems.

WEATHER: Rain in the morning then numerous showers in the afternoon. Highs in the upper 40s to mid 50s. Southwest wind 15 to 30 mph with gusts to 45 in the afternoon. (National Weather Service)
