SITUATION REPORT

INCIDENT NAME: Magone Marine Dutch Harbor Waste Oil **SITREP#:** 1

SPILL NUMBER: 06259904401 **LEDGER CODE:** 14204960

TIME/DATE OF SPILL: The spill occurred as a result of a mudslide into Magone Marine's yard on February 13, 2006. The spill was reported to ADEC on February 14, 2006 at 3:10 PM, by the Department of Emergency Services.

TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: 11:30 AM, February 15, 2006.

TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT: As the situation warrants.

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: Magone Marine Inc. staff indicated 3 punctured waste oil barrels as a result of the mudslide. ADEC's preliminary evaluation estimates a potential release of 165 gallons of waste oil.

LOCATION: Magone Marine Inc. leases its yard from Ounalashka Corporation. The yard is located at 990 Ballyhoo, Dutch Harbor, Alaska.

CAUSE OF SPILL: Mudslide into waste oil storage facility.

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): Magone Marine Services Inc., and/or Ounalashka Corporation.

RESPONSE ACTION: Sorbent pads and sorbent boom have been deployed at the site. Ounalashka Corporation is working to clear the debris from the road to provide access to the site. USCG Marine Safety Detachment personnel have visited the site and have indicated that marine waters have not been affected.

SOURCE CONTROL: Magone Marine and Ounalashka personnel are working to access and recover barrels disrupted by the mudslide.

RESOURCES AFFECTED: Soil and surface water at the Magone Marine yard. USCG Marine Safety Detachment personnel visited the site and indicated that marine waters have not been affected by this spill.

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: Ounalashka Corporation personnel indicated cleanup efforts are ongoing but progress is slow due to the debris in the mud. Two ADEC spill response staff are enroute to Unalaska to assess the spill(s) at the Magone Marine facility and provide technical support.

WEATHER: Mostly cloudy, rain and snow showers in the afternoon. Highs in the upper 30s, South wind increasing to 20 to 30 MPH this afternoon with gusts to 45 MPH.
