SITUATION REPORT

INCIDENT NAME: F/B Ava Lynn & M/V Arch I Grounding

SITREP #: 1

SPILL NUMBER: 06249931401

TIME/DATE OF SPILL: This is a potential spill only. The U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) was notified of the grounding on November 11, 2006 at 9:00 A.M. USCG Marine Safety Detachment Kodiak (MSD) contacted ADEC on November 11, 2006 at 3:00 P.M. The grounding of the freight barge (F/B) *Ava Lynn* occurred during the night of November 10, 2006. While attempting to assess and refloat the barge on November 11, the *M/V Arch I* also was grounded next to the *F/B Ava Lynn*.

TIME/DATE OF SITUATION REPORT: November 13, 2006 at 1:00 p.m.

TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT: As situation warrants.

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: This is a potential spill only. Based upon information from the USCG, no pollution event has occurred. The *F/B Ava Lynn* has several pieces of heavy equipment on board which contain small amounts of diesel fuel and motor oil. The *M/V Arch I* has approximately 6000 gallons of diesel fuel on board.

LOCATION: Both vessels were aground in Chiniak Bay, Kodiak approximately 1000 yards east of the Kodiak Airport. Coordinates: 57° 46.05N, 152° 28.1W

CAUSE OF SPILL: No spill has been reported to the Department at this time.

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): *F/B Ava Lynn* owner, Eric Swenson

RESPONSE ACTION: The *M/V Arch I* has been floated and is now in the Port of Kodiak. This removes the 6000 gallon fuel spill potential. However, the *F/B Ava Lynn* remains stranded on the cobble beach until weather and tide conditions provide sufficient lift to tow the barge from the grounding site. A substantial high tide is needed to perform the removal operation. This is expected to occur later this week. The barge owner/operator made arrangements to have the *M/V Kodiak King* and the *M/V Lazy Bay* assess, plan and perform the salvage operation.

SOURCE CONTROL: No oil or hazardous material release has occurred.

RESOURCES AFFECTED: If the freight barge loses its heavy equipment cargo, the oil could potentially affect Chiniak Bay, which contains marine life, bald eagles, sea birds and shore birds.

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: The USCG MSD Kodiak and ADEC will continue monitoring the situation until the freight barge is safely refloated and damage assessments are completed. The USCG MSD Kodiak is conducting a casualty investigation.

WEATHER: Partly sunny. Isolated snow showers. Highs in the upper 20s to mid 30s. North wind 15 to 30 mph with gusts to 45 mph through channeled terrain. (National Weather Service)
