SITUATION REPORT

INCIDENT NAME: F/V *Aleutian Lady* spill

TIME/DATE OF THE NEXT REPORT: This is the final report.

TYPE/AMOUNT OF PRODUCT SPILLED: The spill occurred aboard the F/V *Aleutian Lady*, a 155-foot steel-hulled fishing vessel. The vessel's operator estimates that 800 gallons of diesel fuel were discharged to Captains Bay.

LOCATION: F/V *Aleutian Lady* was moored at the Offshore Systems, Inc. (OSI) North Pot Dock on Unalaska Island in Captains Bay. The island is located near the eastern end of the Aleutian Chain, approximately 800 air miles southwest of Anchorage, Alaska.

CAUSE OF SPILL: During a transfer of 1,500 gallons of diesel fuel from a port-side tank to a starboard-side tank, fuel overflowed from a vent on the receiving tank. Based on measurements of fuel remaining in the tanks, the vessel's operator estimates that 1,100 gallons of diesel escaped through the vent. An estimated 300 gallons of the overflow was retained in containment aboard the vessel, but the remainder flowed overboard. The cause of the spill is being investigated by the US Coast Guard (USCG).

POTENTIAL RESPONSIBLE PARTY (PRP): Shelford Investments LLC

RESPONSE ACTION: OSI's Response Team assisted Magone Marine and the *Aleutian Lady*'s crew in deploying absorbent boom, sweep, and pads to contain and cleanup the spilled fuel. Spilled diesel initially reached the shoreline one quarter-mile north of the OSI Pot Dock, but the majority of the fuel collected during the flood tide approximately one half-mile north of the dock. Many rows of absorbent sweep, boom and pads were used to contain the spilled fuel for cleanup. USCG Marine Safety Detachment Unalaska continues to monitor the situation.

SOURCE CONTROL: The internal fuel transfer was stopped and all spilled fuel that remained aboard the F/V *Aleutian Lady* was cleaned up. No additional fuel is escaping from the F/V *Aleutian Lady*.

RESOURCES AFFECTED: There have been no reports of impacts to wildlife. Approximately one quarter-mile of shoreline north of the OSI Pot Dock was impacted. A light sheen is emanating from the shoreline.

FUTURE PLANS AND RECOMMENDATIONS: The USCG Marine Safety Detachment Unalaska will continue shoreline assessment and will monitor progress of the removal of diesel fuel from the shoreline.

WEATHER: Temperature 38°F, partly cloudy, winds 17 mph from Southwest. Tonight: 34°F, 20% chance of rain, winds increasing 30-40 mph with gusts of 55 mph.


