PUBLIC NOTICE
Request for public comments on Notice of Intent
to discharge bark and wood debris in Edna Bay, Kosciusko Island from a New
Log Transfer Facility

The Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) is soliciting public comment on a Notice of Intent (NOI) submitted by **Alaska Department of Natural Resources, Division of Forestry** to discharge bark and wood debris in **Edna Bay, Kosciusko Island** from log storage and transfer activities at the **State of Alaska Edna Bay LTF**. The NOI has been submitted to DEC under the Alaska Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (APDES) General Permit for Log Transfer Facilities (AKG701000). This permit will expire **March 31, 2020**.

DEC has evaluated the NOI and finds that the proposed discharge is consistent with the requirements of Permit AKG701000. DEC is publicly noticing its decision to authorize the discharge of bark and wood waste into waters of the State under AKG701000.

For purposes of this public notice, DEC specifically seeks public comment on the following:

a) DEC's decision to authorize the Notice of Intent, b) existing uses of the waterbody, and c) any additional issues that may affect the final permitting decision.
